**Classroom Community Supplies**

- 3 highlighters (variety of colors)
- 1 box of thin classic colored markers
- 1 box (24 ct) of classic long colored pencils
- 5 glue sticks
- Scissors
- 4 packs of sticky notes (post-its)
- 1 ream of copy paper
- 1 composition book (extra for teacher to hold onto when run out of pages)
